CNW MEN'S 1ST GRADE GRAND FINAL

Ulverstone District Cricket Club has claimed its 14th NWTCA/CNW 1st Grade flag and fourth in succession with a convincing outright win over Sheffield in the 2024-2025 decider at the Latrobe Recreation Ground on Sunday.

Matthew Varner claimed his second consecutive Dale Baker medal for man of the match thanks to his two hauls of 4-26 and 3-25, with the latter including a marathon 12-over spell to start day three.



It is the second time Ulverstone have claimed four 1st Grade flags in a row after their triumphs between 2010-2011 and 2014-2015, and cements their standing as a modern-day goliath of the competition.
