What is the Posts feature in PlayHQ?

The **Posts** tool helps club and association admins send important messages to players, coaches, and other members via the PlayHQ admin portal.

Admins can:

- Add a title, message, and image
- Choose who sees the post (eg. players or coaches)
- Save drafts, edit posts later, or remove them when they're not needed

Important: Posts should only be used for **important updates**, also known as service communications, and not for ads or promotions.

If the message helps someone *do* something they've already signed up for (like checking fixtures or updating scores), it's **service**. If it's trying to get them to *join, buy,* or *attend* something new, it's **marketing**.

CERTIFICATE OF CURRENCY – MARSH INSURANCE

Associations and Clubs are asked to download their Certificate of Currency (CoC) for public liability insurance. Last year's certificate was issued for a two-year period, meaning different actions apply depending on whether your club downloaded it in the 2024/25 season.

For Clubs That Have Already Downloaded Their CoC in 2024/25:

Your certificate remains valid until 30 June 2026 — there is no need to download it again this season.

For Clubs That Have Not Downloaded Their CoC in 2024/25:

You can still access your CoC via the Marsh CoC Portal. Cricket Club | Marsh

Making a Claim: Make a claim | Marsh

If a participant or volunteer needs to make a claim, they must do so directly through Marsh.

Game and Match Day Checklist: Cricket Check List | Marsh

We highly encourage all clubs to use the Match Day Checklist prior to games. This should be completed jointly by both coaches or captains to agree on the suitability of the ground.

The checklist helps identify and manage potential injury risks and includes features such as:

- Pre-formatted checklist
- Ability to submit electronically
- Upload and attach photos
- Guidelines to identify and address hazards

CLUB DEVELOPMENT FUNDING

Cricket Tasmania is pleased to announce that Club and Association Development Funding will soon open for season 2025/26.

To be eligible to apply for this season's Club and Association Development Funding clubs must be:

- Successfully affiliated with Cricket Tasmania
- Last season ran or are planning to introduce a Cricket Blast program, Junior program or Women's program (if your club or association do not fit into any of these categories and wish to apply for funding please contact your local Cricket Manager)
- Have discussed your application with your local Community Cricket Manager (see contact details at the bottom of this information).

This season there will be one round of funding covering three different categories with clubs invited to apply for up to \$2,000.00 total for initiatives linked to Cricket Tasmania Community Cricket Strategy, including:

- Recruitment and Promotion up to \$500
- Quality Experiences up to \$1000
- Volunteer Support and Recognition up to \$500

Funding applications which cover multiple areas of the CT Community Cricket Strategy will be looked upon favourably to receive the full amount of funding. Once clubs have applied, Cricket Tasmania Community Cricket staff will assess applications and contact clubs with the outcome of their application.

Applications open on Friday August 1st 2025 and will remain open until all funds have been exhausted.

COACH REGISTRATION PROCESS – MANDATORY PLAYHQ REGISTRATION

Cricket Tasmania wishes to inform clubs and associations that it will be enforcing mandatory PlayHQ registration for all coaches in Senior and Junior Cricket this season.

Coaches will register via PlayHQ in a similar process to players registering (noting they do not need to pay the NRF) and will need to provide their WWVP details during the registration process.

Spot checks based on the WWVP data provided on PlayHQ will be conducted throughout the season.
