CNW SENIOR COMPETITONS – CONFIRMED ROSTER DATES

Cricket Tasmania in conjunction with the CNW Board have now completed rosters for CNW Men's 1st Grade and Men's 2nd Grade. These are now live on PlayHQ and can be viewed via the CNW PlayHQ Website here and via the PlayCricket App.

It is each clubs individual responsibility to pass these rosters onto their own councils. Clubs are asked to please do this at their earliest convenience to ensure there are no issues with ground clashes.

Please note: As you can appreciate there are many layers of complexity, with roster requests, ground availabilities, Greater Northern Raiders schedules and various other factors that all contribute and minor changes impact both CN and CNW competition rosters.

These rosters may be subject to minor changes due to ground availabilities pending when grounds are online.

A full agenda will be emailed to all CNW female clubs as well as non-CNW Women's Social League clubs ahead of the meeting.


CNW 75TH ANNIVERSARY & 2025/26 SEASON LAUNCH

CLUB DEVELOPMENT FUNDING - REMINDER

Cricket Tasmania is pleased to announce that Club and Association Development Funding will soon open for season 2025/26.

To be eligible to apply for this season's Club and Association Development Funding clubs must be:

- Successfully affiliated with Cricket Tasmania
- Last season ran or are planning to introduce a Cricket Blast program, Junior program or Women's program (if your club or association do not fit into any of these categories and wish to apply for funding please contact your local Cricket Manager)
- Have discussed your application with your local Community Cricket Manager (see contact details at the bottom of this information).

This season there will be one round of funding covering three different categories with clubs invited to apply for up to \$2,000.00 total for initiatives linked to Cricket Tasmania Community Cricket Strategy, including:

- Recruitment and Promotion up to \$500
- Quality Experiences up to \$1000
- Volunteer Support and Recognition up to \$500

Funding applications which cover multiple areas of the CT Community Cricket Strategy will be looked upon favourably to receive the full amount of funding. Once clubs have applied, Cricket Tasmania Community Cricket staff will assess applications and contact clubs with the outcome of their application.
