Cricket Tasmania is pleased to announce details of the TasWater Hurricanes Junior League Holiday Gala Events which will be held in the Devonport and Launceston regions in the Summer Holidays in January 2026.

Please see below the key details of the event for clubs information.

**Launceston Gala Event** - January 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> 2026

**Devonport Gala Event** - January 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> 2026

**Age Groups** – Under 12s and Under 14s competition with local rules regarding age restrictions applying.

**Rules and Formats** – All games will be played as Twenty-20s with standard Stage 1 (Under 12s) and Stage 2 (Under 14s) rules applying. Standard local rules will apply to games with a full rulebook being sent out prior to the competition.

**Rosters** – Each team will play 2 x games per day pending number of team nominations and ground availability.

**Balls** – Cricket Tasmania will supply 2 x balls for each team to use throughout the tournament. Teams will use 1 x ball each day. CT will incur the cost for these balls.

**Ground Bookings** – Cricket Tasmania will book all grounds and incur the costs for these bookings.

**Finals and Ladders** – There will be no ladders or finals for this event.

**Match Management** – as per normal Junior Cricket teams will be required to assist with ground set-up (first game), umpiring, scoring and ground pack-up (last game)

**Team Nominations** – Clubs can choose to nominate as many teams as they wish in each division and can nominated in either or both regions should they wish to. Team nominations will open soon and be finalised by Friday December 19<sup>th</sup>
