### CNW MEN'S SECOND GRADE ONE-DAY CUP GRAND FINAL

Congratulations to the Devonport Cricket Club on taking out yesterday's 2nd Grade One-Day Cup grand final at the Devonport Oval.

Up against Burnie in the decider, the Orions bowled first and restricted the Hurricanes to 9-156 from their 45 overs, with Sam Fogg taking 3-27 while Chris Lindsay (2-8) and Jake Glover (2-35) were the other multiple wicket takers.

For Burnie, James Radcliff top-scored with 44, while Nathan Hayes and Nick Imms added 27 and 24 respectively. The game was in the balance during the chase when Devonport fell to 6-98 thanks to three wickets from Lindsay Skeggs (3-24), including the dismissal of Brad Moore for 31.

But the home side recovered and took the victory through an unbeaten 59-run stand between Kai Wilson (32 not out) and Glover (25 not out).

This is Devonport's second one-day cup triumph after taking out the trophy in the 2022-2023 season.



### CNW MEN'S SOCIAL LEAGUE COMPETITION – PLAYER REGISTRATION

With the CNW Men's Social League getting underway over the weekend, we would like to remind clubs of the importance of ensuring all players are registered online prior to taking the field.

We understand that historically there has been a culture within social league of players simply turning up to play. However, moving forward, it is important that this approach changes. As with other sports, player registration is a requirement, not an optional extra, and plays a critical role in areas such as insurance coverage, eligibility, and overall competition integrity.

We acknowledge that with a short Social League season (three matches), some players may be unsure of their availability for all games. That said, players are still required to complete an online registration if they intend to participate, above the one game allowed as a fill in player.

We have already seen registrations and rules being correctly followed with the first round of Men's Social League, which is encouraging. To avoid any issues on match day, we strongly encourage clubs to proactively remind their players to register as soon as possible.

This reminder also applies to Women's Social Cricket and Women's Second Grade and Boys Under 18's competitions, where the same registration requirements are in place.
